Question 1: Drawing MD-101 calls for removing existing 14x10 exhaust louver, fan 53 and ductwork. It says to refer to architectural details for patching. We are not seeing it on the drawings. Please advise.

Answer: Infill existing exterior wall with metal framing, glass mat sheathing and board insulation and waterproofing to match existing wall assembly. At the exterior, re-install existing louver.

Question 2: Is this a wage scale job?

Answer: No.

Question 3: The wood door specifications are saying the doors are to match existing. Can you please provide the cut and species of wood doors for this project?

Answer: Contractor shall submit door & finish samples for Architect's approval.

Question 4: What is the existing key system the SMCM uses? The hardware specification is saying to match existing key system. Please advise.

Answer: The SMCM standard is Best hardware, provide with construction cores and keys.
